- Implements behavior intervention strategies as decided upon in team meetings and/or as directed by a Lead Therapist or Program Supervisor
- Implements program changes as decided upon in team meetings and/or as directed by a Lead Therapist or Program Supervisor
- Receives feedback in a professional manner
- Implements feedback received
- Submits changes in schedule promptly and to appropriate persons
- Documents session times on Sign-In Sheets and Timesheets, and obtain caregiver signatures
- Completes timesheets accurately and completely
